**Critical legislative support on Capitol Hill.** *ACSSS has and will continue to testify on all major thrift legislation that may impact the state-chartered thrift system. Our legislative counsel and well-known thrift lobbyist, Jim Butera, has continuous personal contact with legislators to convey the association's views. Mr. Butera conducts a monthly conference call with the ACSSS Board to discuss the latest developments on legislative and regulatory issues. This benefit eliminates the need for you to attempt the monumental task of monitoring and reacting daily to legislative changes in Washington.*

**Participation on the Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council (FFIEC) Committees.** *ACSSS is represented on the FFIEC's Task Force on Supervision and Information Sharing. In addition, ACSSS is serving a 2-year term on the FFIEC State Liaison Committee. Your voice is heard and well represented through the association's participation.*
